- 4. WAIT: We will ALWAYS be with the LORD (4:13-5:11)
 - 1. ENCOURAGE one another with HOPE & towards SOBRIETY (4:18; 5:11)

5. CERTAINTY: He will SURELY do it (5:23-24)

6. How are you at waiting? How does Christ's return impact your life today? How could it impact your life more?

7. How does the certainty of Paul in 1 Thessalonians 5:23-24 tie everything together? Are you prone to see the future of the body of Christ, yourself included, as a possibility or as a promise?
