- 4. Be loving by asking GOOD QUESTIONS.
- 5. Be equipped to share JESUS from the BIBLE.

What Not-Yet-Christians can learn from the Ethiopian Eunuch

- 1. Be SEEKING TRUTH.
- 2. Be open to SPIRITUAL GUIDANCE.
- 3. Be clear that the Gospel is Good News about JESUS for YOU.
- 4. Be willing to COMMIT.
- 5. Be ready for JOY.
