5. How do believers and unbelievers grieve differently at the death of a loved one and why? Have you observed/experienced this personally?

6. The Gospel, in all its dimensions, is Good News and practical. So how is the Good News of the return of Jesus meant to inform and impact our lives right now?

7. What does it mean in 4:18 to "Comfort one another with these words"? What does that look like? How do we do it?
