We all have different **PERSONALITIES** and **PERSPECTIVES**. There are too many SOULS at stake to be arguing about our OPINIONS.

God's people will be USED BY GOD to ACCOMPLISH His work.

They **DISAGREED**, parted ways, and God **WORKED** through the **CONFLICT**.

No matter the personal **STRUGGLE**, **DIFFERENCES**, or **DISCORD**, God will still do His **WORK**.

Apostle transformed by Jesus on the road to Damascus Missionary
Church planter

Theologian

Former Christian Killer

Barnabas:

Disciple from Jerusalem
Teacher and leader in the church
Invested in younger leaders
Known as the "son of encouragement"
Rebuked by Paul in Galatians 2

John Mark:

Disciple from Jerusalem
Mother is Mary who hosted prayer meetings
Barnabas' cousin
Deserted Paul and Barnabas on First Missionary Journey
Wrote the Gospel of Mark between A.D. 55 and 59

Silas:

Leader and teacher in the church

Spent time with Paul and Barnabas in Antioch

Chosen by Paul for Second Missionary Journey

Known as faithful by other disciples

Served with Peter and delivered letter of 1st Peter
