1. Read 1 Peter 1-2:3. What truth is celebrated in 1:3 and then reiterated in 1:23? What is the agency of this miracle in each verse? To put it another way, “through” what does this miracle happen in each verse?
2. What kind of metaphor is Peter playing with beginning in 1:23 and continuing all the way through 1:25? Explain it. What do we learn about us? What do we learn about God’s Word? What do we learn about what God’s Word does to us?
3. What kind of metaphor does Peter employ in 2:2? What does this metaphor have in common with the one used earlier? What truths are being communicated?
4. Without looking at the outline, see if you can hunt down the “5 things that the Bible is” in 1:23-2:3. See if you can hunt down the “3 things the Bible does” in our lives.
5. What other passages can you recall which speak of the value and power of God’s Word and how we are to handle it?
