Dangers that distract us followers of Jesus from the MULTIPLY mission of Jesus . . .

1. KINGDOM CONFUSION (1:6-8)

(We can become too EARTHLY-minded.)

- The Gospel of the Kingdom is not POLITICAL, but SPIRITUAL.
- The Gospel of the Kingdom is not NATIONAL, but GLOBAL.
- The Gospel of the Kingdom is not IMMEDIATE, but GROWS GRADUALLY.

2. SKY-GAZING (1:9-11)

(We can become too HEAVENLY-minded)

- Our mission is not to be SKY GAZERS, but to be WITNESSES to the WORLD.
- Jesus has gone, but is coming again. In the meantime, we have a MISSION to accomplish by the SPIRIT He's given.

- 4. Selecting a new 12TH APOSTLE to replace Judas (1:15-26)
