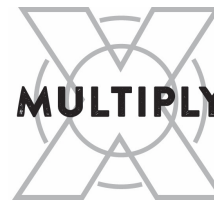


3. Commission: REPENT & Be a BLESSING (3:17–26)

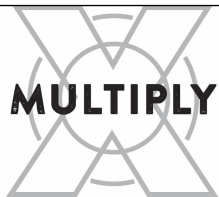
This week we enter into the first major miracle of Jesus through his apostles post-Pentecost. This miracle creates the context for the call to repentance, faith and to fulfill the mission to be a blessing to all the families of the earth.

1. Context: The Undeniable MIRACLE (3:1–10)

- Matter of Fact Miracle
 - Who (3:1–2)
 - Where (3:1)
 - When (3:1)
 - How (3:3–7)
 - What (3:8–10; 4:16)
 - Why (3:11ff)

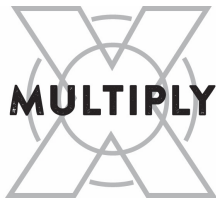
2. Conviction: You Denied the MIRACLE–WORKING Messiah (3:11–16)

- Not by our Power (3:12)
 - Not by our Piety (3:12)
 - Rather, by God's Servant, Jesus (3:13)
 - The Holy & Righteous One (3:14)
- The Author of Life (3:15)
- Conclusion: Jesus is the Miracle Worker (3:16)
