CONNECT *(ask these questions to check-in with your group)*

Discuss doing a Thanksgathering meal with your group and ask, "who can we invite?"

DISCUSS *(use some of these questions to process God's Word together)*

1. Read Hebrews 2:17-3:6. How did you come under the authority of God's word through this text and the message this week? What stuck out to you?
2. Why does the author ask us to consider Jesus? What is the significance of the word "consider"?
3. Discuss the illustration of the house in verses 3-6. Why is Jesus so much greater than Moses?

4. Why does the fact that Jesus is Himself our confidence, boast, and hope free us when we fail to consider and glorify Him?

5. Growth Group as FAMILY: How can we encourage one another to consider, glorify, and hope in Jesus this week? Let's get practical!

PRAY *(use these prompts to pray in response to God's Word)*

- With Hebrews open in front of you, pray that God, by the power of the Holy Spirit, would help you consider, glorify, and hope in Jesus.
- Pray for those you know who don't know Jesus and pray for opportunities to share Jesus with them.
