 Jesus came to give LIGHT to a dark world... light to guide our path into the way of PEACE.

Zechariah's Song

Luke 1:67-79 Sunday, December 23, 2018

Zechariah's song of prophetic praise, called the Benedictus, comes after 9 months of not being able to hear or speak. It speaks of the coming of Jesus as the horn of salvation from the house of David . . .

The backstory . . . God's presence in our SILENCE! (Luke 1:5-24, 57-66)

Jesus' coming as our REDEEMER provides SALVATION.

(Luke 1:68-77, Hebrews 9:22, Romans 5:8, Ephesians 1:7)

· The horn of salvation is a symbol of STRENGTH and VICTORY.

· Zechariah is singing here that this horn of salvation is JESUS.

Jesus' salvation fulfills PROPHECY.

(Luke 1:70-73, 2 Samuel 22:2-3)
